What is PEF?


Pupil Equity Funding (PEF) is additional funding allocated by the Scottish Government to schools, and targeted at closing the poverty related attainment gap.

- Participatory Budgeting for learning community.
- Reducing the Cost of the School Day for families.
- Parental Support Opportunities.



TARGETED

- Specific Literacy and Numeracy Interventions to promote attainment.
- Health and Wellbeing Support.
- Access to a digital device to support learning in school and at home.
- Referral system in place for Family Link Worker e.g. walking bus/direct support.
- Extra curricular activities.

INTENSIVE

- Increased staffing levels to support
- 1-1 Tutoring &
- Small group support.
- Individualised learning plans.
- Bespoke programmes for individuals
